The **Grace** of God
is not a license to sin.

- God's Grace must never be isolated from the rest of the teaching of the New Testament.
- God's Grace isn't a permission to sin but the power to overcome sin.
- God's Grace will always encourage and enable us to resist temptation and sin.
- Grace gives us the power to live right not the right to live wrong.
- There is absolutely nothing in the Bible - including God's grace that indicates God is light on sin.
- Grace is never the divine permission to do wrong. Grace is divine empowerment to do what is right.
